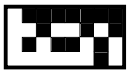

Inclusion Criteria

- yes no 1. Patient has an invasive breast carcinoma documented with either FNA, core, incisional or excisional biopsy, OR, the patient has a high suspicion of breast cancer and will undergo an excisional biopsy and definitive cancer therapy under one anesthetic.
- yes no 2. Patient is selected for lumpectomy, axillary node dissection and radiation therapy, or modified radical mastectomy to treat the primary breast cancer.
- yes no 3. Patient is between the ages of 18 and 80 years.
- yes no 4. Did the patient sign the consent form for the DOD trial.

If the answer to any of the above questions is NO, the patient is NOT eligible for the study.

Exclusion Criteria

- yes no 1. Patient is pregnant.
- yes no 2. Patient has clinical or radiologic evidence of metastatic disease.
- yes no 3. Patient has had a second primary malignancy within the past 5 years.
- yes no 4. Patient has more than one metachronous infiltrating cancer in the same breast.
- yes no 5. Patient has had previous chemotherapy, radiotherapy, or immunotherapy within the past 5 years.
- yes no 6. Patient has a history of organ transplantation.
- yes no 7. Patient has a history or major psychiatric illness.
- yes no 8. Patient has had prior surgery in the region of the breast or axillae that would disrupt normal lymphatic drainage patterns (such as breast implants or axillary dissection).
- yes no 9. Patient has a life expectancy of less than 5 years.
- yes no 10. Patient has an allergy to Isosulfan blue dye or related compounds.
